PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

He/She manages the site supervision team to ensure compliance with the services/design/QA/QC/schedule/logistics and works closely with the contractor's construction and engineering team.

Furthermore, the Engineer will manage the documentation and monitoring the construction process and progress, will review daily and weekly reports as well as monthly and final summary reports produced by the waterproofing team members, provide technical engineering information/reports and interpretation of plans, detail sheets and specifications and participate in the acquisition process.
